3 NATIONAL FINALISTS, 3 TOP 10 PLACEMENTS, & 1 NATIONAL CHAMPION

(July 3, 2025) – Iowa Future Business Leaders of America (FBLA) students made their mark at the 2025 FBLA National Leadership Conference from June 29 - July 2. FBLA is the nation's largest Career and Technical Student Organization focused on business. Members showcased their exceptional skills and professionalism, earning top placements and recognition among talented students nationwide. The event, held in Anaheim, California, attracted nearly 16,000 of the nation's top middle and high school students. 179 attendees represented Iowa at the conference and achieved outstanding results, securing several top placements.

FBLA's National Leadership Conference brings together students to compete for scholarships in dozens of competitive events over four days. Students also had the opportunity to engage in learning workshops, network with members, engage in a variety of activities in the Future Leader's Expo Hall, and explore Anaheim.

Furthermore, students and advisers were recognized for their contributions to FBLA throughout the past year. Sriya Munjuluri (Waukee) was recognized as the Who's Who recipient for Iowa FBLA. Andrew Thonstad, FBLA Adviser at Sioux Center was acknowledged as the Outstanding Local Chapter Adviser for the state of Iowa. Both were recognized in the Parade of States at the Opening Ceremony, along with State President, Caroline Van Pelt (Fairfield).

Finally, Iowa FBLA is pleased to recognize Aditya Pethe (Waukee Northwest) and Sriya Munjuluri (Waukee). Both of these outstanding student leaders went through the process of running for national office at the 2025 National Leadership Conference. Both students spent the last few months building a rigorous campaign and studying testing materials for hours in order to prepare to compete against top candidates across the country. We are extremely proud of their efforts and the way they represented our state.
